


2025 Alaska Bald Eagle Tour

Cathedral Peaks were a spectacular backdrop for the whole event. Unreal!


- Daily viewing excursions through the Chilkat Bald Eagle Preserve.

Witness an Annual Spectacle, Only in Alaska

In the early winter months, eagles migrate to the Chilkat River in Haines to feed on the last salmon run in the state. Instead of freezing, the water here continues to flow through sections of the Bald Eagle Preserve, causing the eagles to congregate and fight over high-calorie, end-of-season meals. Last year, more than 2,000 bald eagles descended on Haines for exceptional viewing.

On the tour, we travel into the preserve in a touring van. En route to and from the preserve, we'll keep an eye out for mountain goats, big horn sheep, and moose. Several viewing areas allow for different image opportunities. On one day, we make a special private visit to the Kroschel Wildlife Preserve for other photo ops, including lynx and wolverine (TBD).



Where We Stay, Eat, Dream, and Play


Guests stay at the Captain's Choice or comparable property conveniently located in downtown Haines on Main Street, overlooking the harbor.

All guiding, activities, photo instruction, and meals are included, as well as the ferry ride** to and from Juneau to Haines.

Other activities in Haines may include the Haines Distillery, Haines Brewing Company, Fort Seward, the Hammer Museum, and the Native Heritage Center.

Daily photography instruction and image sharing will take place in the evenings. We'll also check the local aurora forecast for northern lights opportunities and look for bears and wolves within the preserve.

DATES: 11/12-11/19, 2025

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TRANSPORTATION

Please arrive on 11/12 in Juneau. We will meet for a group dinner at the hotel at 6pm to kick off the tour. Please note: Airfare to and from your departure city and Juneau is <u>not</u> included in the trip fee. We'll explore Juneau and Mendenhall Glacier on 11/13.

Our ferry will leave on Friday, 11/14 at 7am sharp.** We return in the evening on Tuesday, 11/18. Guests will either depart from Juneau for red eye flights home that night or choose to stay in Juneau. Accomodations in Juneau on 11/18 are included. Guests depart at their leisure on 11/19.

INCLUSIONS AND EXCLUSIONS Inclusions:

All meals 11/12-11/18, starting with dinner on 11/12 - dinner on 11/18 on the ferry. Ferry passage to and from Juneau and Haines.** Guided daily trips into the bald eagle preserve 11/14-11/18. Private viewing at Kroschel Wildlife Preserve (if available). Guiding, photography instruction, accomodations in Haines and Juneau, park fees, lodging, and taxes.

Exclusions:

Airfare and transportation from your home city to and from Juneau. Baggage charges. Gratuities. Recommended gear: A suggested packing list will be provided upon trip registration. Examples include: rain jacket, camera equipment, daypack, gloves, hat, waterproof winter coat, hand and foot warmers.

TRIP INSURANCE

As with any excursion, trip insurance is highly recommended in case of illness, weather delays, or unforseen cancelations. We take ferries because they are less affected by weather than planes; however, schedule changes can still occur.

TOTAL COST

\$7,900 per person (no additional fees for single rooms / no discounts for sharing).

NOTE: This trip offers a 100% eagle guarantee. See a bald eagle or get your deposit refunded.
